- » facilitate valuable discussions and feedback on the research studies of the Honours/PhD students and post-doctoral researchers.

All Honours, PhD and early-career researchers students are encouraged to apply, even if you do not have results yet! Don't miss this opportunity to develop your working relationships with your co-supervisors and get to know peers, friends, and future collaborators through their research presentations and through informal online interaction.

## Research areas and format

All Honours, PhD, and early-career researchers using ACNS or NDF facilities are welcomed and encouraged to participate. The last Clip Day in 2021 included talks from over 30 participants, and spanned many disciplines including medicine, mining, transportation, food processing and more.

The format will consist of 10 or 15 minute oral presentations and posters with accompanying pre-recorded voice overs/video. The length of the oral presentation offered will depend upon the completion status of your studies or project (don't worry if your research is in its early stages or has been COVID-19 impacted!). We are also planning a few guest lectures on proposal writing and other useful topics!
