Jia-Wei Wu - School of Life Sciences, Tsinghua University, China.

Professor Jia-Wei Wu research interests include studying structure and function of key molecules in metabolism and regulatory mechanisms of kinases and phosphatases in cell signaling.

Dr. Lin's lab focuses on understanding the influence of dimensionality on

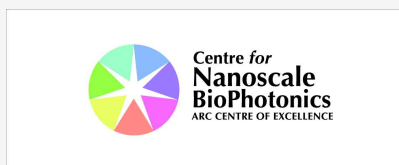
